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The Proclamation of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium of Peace & Wisdom

- The “Second Child” Prophesied in the Bible (Revelation 12, 14, 16, 19 & 20)

Fifty years ago, American singer Johnny Mathis released a new Christmas song, “*When a Child Is Born*”, which became a major hit in the United Kingdom, topping the UK Singles Chart for three consecutive weeks in December 1976.

While most listeners assumed it was simply another traditional carol commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ two thousand years earlier, this song—written by Fred Jay—actually refers to the birth of the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible: the “Male Child” born under the reign of the “Red Dragon” prophesied in the Book of Revelation (12:5). After growing up, this “Male Child” would emerge as the “Rider on the White Horse” in Revelation (19:11-21), the Messiah of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium.

Therefore, this beautiful poetic song, “*When a Child Is Born*”, is the first and only Christmas song written for the birth of the Messiah of the “Second Coming”, rather than for the Baby Jesus born two millennia ago.

In fact, I am that “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible in the Book of Revelation 12:5, and I am that “child” this song was written for.

I am aware that many people may have hard time to accept this fact. Some may view this claim as blasphemous and may even label me a false prophet or the Antichrist. I fully understand such reactions. After all, Jesus Christ himself was accused of blasphemy when he declared himself the Son of God, and he was ultimately crucified for that declaration. Holding this position is inherently challenging and is certain to draw criticism and opposition from individuals across many faiths.

As Jesus warned his disciples on the Mount of Olives concerning the end times, many false prophets and false Christs would arise, claiming to come in his name. That prophecy has been fulfilled throughout the past two thousand years, particularly in recent decades. Nevertheless, after the long succession of false prophets and false Christs, the true Messiah of the “Second Coming” will also appear, as the signs of the “Second Coming” have appeared all across the world since the beginning of the New Millennium. The central question remains: How will people of faith distinguish the authentic Messiah of the Second Coming from all those who have falsely claimed that title?

I. How to Recognize the True Messiah of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium

In recent decades, many false prophets and false Christs have claimed to be the “Second Coming” of Jesus Christ. They thought they could make any extravagant claims they wished without meeting any divine qualification or prophetic requirements. They simply did not understand the specific prophetic qualifications that the true Christ or Messiah of the “Second Coming” must fulfill.

In fact, God has already revealed in the Bible the key criterion for distinguishing the true Messiah of the "Second Coming" from all those false self-claimers. It is not the supernatural spectacle of Christ descending from the sky with thousands of angels, but rather the final book of the Bible—the Book of Revelation.

There are many prophecies concerning the “Second Coming” in the New Testament of the Bible, but the Book of Revelation constitutes the complete and final version of all biblical prophecies. This is affirmed in its closing verses: **“I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this scroll: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this scroll. 19 And if anyone takes words away from this scroll of prophecy, God will take away from that person any share in the tree of life and in the Holy City, which are described in this scroll.”** (Revelation 22:18-19)

For the past two thousand years, most people have believed that the “Second Coming” of Christ the Messiah would be a supernatural event in which Christ descends from the sky with thousands of angels following Him. This is what Jesus foretold to His disciples on the Mount of Olives when He spoke about the end times—that people would see **“the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory.”** (Matthew 24:30)

However, this was a metaphor Jesus often used to describe spiritual realities, just as He once said, **“Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”** (John 2:19-21). He was not speaking about the physical temple in Jerusalem, but about His own body, foretelling His death and resurrection in three days. If people only rely on a strictly literal interpretation of Jesus’ metaphor, they will miss the point entirely.

In the Book of Revelation, there are many visions depicting the interaction between heaven and earth through the angels with trumpets and bowls of God’s judgment. Yet in our physical world, we see only the historical events carried out by human leaders on earth, not the seven angels blowing seven trumpets in Revelation 8-9 nor the seven angels pouring the seven bowls of God’s wrath in Revelation 15-16. Those angels carrying out their missions of God are only visible in the spiritual realm, not in our physical world. The same principle applies to the “Second Coming” of Christ the Messiah and His armies of heavenly hosts.

Therefore, in our physical world, people will not see any supernatural phenomenon of Christ descending from the sky with thousands of angels following Him, as these events occur only in the spiritual realm, which is invisible to us. In our physical world, the Messiah of the “Second Coming” and all His angels have already manifested as ordinary people on earth—just as Jesus and John the Baptist appeared as normal people during their “First Coming” two thousand years ago.

The real “Second Coming” on earth began with the birth of the “Man Child” born under the reign of the “Red Dragon” in Chapter 12 of the Book of Revelation. This “Man Child” in Revelation 12:5 is the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible, as Jesus was the “First Child” prophesied in the Bible in Isaiah 9:6. He would grow up and come out as the “Rider on a White Horse” in Revelation 19:11-21 after his spiritual awakening. This “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible (Revelation 12:5) is the Messiah of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium Kingdom as prophesied in the Book of Revelation (19:11-20:5).

Many people in the past thought this prophecy of the birth of the “Man Child” born under the reign of the “Red Dragon” referred to the birth of Jesus Christ two thousand years ago. However, they overlooked the fact that biblical prophecy always foretells future events, not things that have already occurred. When John was lifted up to heaven from the island of Patmos, a voice clearly told him, **“Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.”** (Revelation 4:1)

Therefore, all the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation concern future events after the first century, not events that had already taken place. This “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible (Revelation 12:5) is

the Messiah of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium, not the Baby Jesus of the “First Coming” two thousand years ago. In fact, God specifically prophesied the five stages of the “Second Coming” of this “Second Child” in the Book of the Revelation.

1. The Five Stages of the “Second Coming” Prophesied in the Book of Revelation

- 1) **The First Stage of the “Second Coming”**
 - The Birth of the “Male Child” under the Reign of the “Red Dragon” (Revelation 12:1-5)
- 2) **The Second Stage of the “Second Coming”**
 - The Spiritual Awakening of the Son of Man in the “State of Zion” (Revelation 14:1-5)
- 3) **The Third Stage of the “Second Coming”**
 - The New Revelation of the “Eternal Gospel” for every nation (Revelation 14: 6-12)
- 4) **The Fourth Stage of the “Second Coming”**
 - The Warning of the Messiah before the Catastrophe of “Armageddon” (Revelation 16: 15-16)
- 5) **The Fifth Stage of the “Second Coming”**
 - The Grand Finale of the “Second Coming” of the Messiah (Revelation 19:11-21) for the New Millennium of Peace & Wisdom (Revelation 20:1-6)

For the past two thousand years, no one fully understood the true meaning of these visions. Only the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible knows how these prophecies are to be fulfilled. Many false prophets and false Christs had no clue what these visions really mean, let alone the ability to fulfill these prophecies. If anyone claims to be the Messiah of the “Second Coming” yet has no knowledge how these Five Stages of the “Second Coming”, as prophesied in the Book of Revelation, were fulfilled, then that person is a false prophet or false Christ. This is the first key to distinguishing the true Messiah of the “Second Coming” from all false prophets and false Christs.

2. The Authority to Unseal the Mystery of the Visions in the Book of Revelation

In Chapter 5 of the Book of Revelation, when the Lord who sat on the throne handed out a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals, a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, “Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?” But “**no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth could open the scroll or even look inside it.**” **Only Christ the Lamb is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll.** (Revelation 5:1-14)

However, since the Book of Revelation was revealed around 90 AD, no one has been able to decode the real meaning of these visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation, because, in the same way, only Christ the Messiah of the “Second Coming” is worthy to unseal the mystery of those visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation. That’s why no one in the past two thousand years could decode these visions in the Book of Revelation.

Now, as this “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible has come with the “Authority of the Messiah” (Revelation 12:10), he will have the authority to unseal the 2,000-year mystery of the visions on the scroll

in the Book of Revelation. This is the second key to distinguishing the true Messiah of the “Second Coming” from false prophets and false Christs, as those false prophets and false Christs have no idea what those visions on the scroll really mean in the Book of Revelation.

Therefore, the Book of Revelation, the final version of all the prophecies in the Bible that no one can add or delete, is the key to distinguishing the true Messiah of the “Second Coming” from false prophets and false Christs. **The true Christ the Messiah of the “Second Coming” not only needs to fulfill the prophecies of the Five Stages of the “Second Coming” as prophesied in the Book of Revelation, but also needs to have the “Authority of the Messiah” to decode the 2,000-year mystery of the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation.**

For the past several decades, many false prophets and false Christs (or Messiahs) have appeared, exactly as Jesus forewarned in His Olivet Discourse two thousand years ago. Even some people of faith were deceived. However, none of these false prophets or false Christs have any understanding of what the visions in the Book of Revelation truly mean, let alone the ability to fulfill the prophecies of the “Five Stages of the Second Coming.” Only the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible—who was caught up to the throne of God (Revelation 12:5)—knows how these visions on the scroll have been fulfilled, for he himself is an integral part of the prophecies in the Book of Revelation.

Now, as the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible, I will unveil the two-thousand-year mystery of the visions in the Book of Revelation by presenting historical evidence from major events in the Christian world over the past two millennia. Once people learn the true meaning of these visions in the Book of Revelation, they will understand how God has been guiding the human history and judging from the spiritual realm behind the major events of the world. Through the historical fulfillment of these visions on the scroll, people will also understand how to distinguish the true Messiah of the “Second Coming” from all false claimants.

II. Unveiling the 2,000-year Mystery of the Visions in the Book of Revelation

For the past two thousand years, the Book of Revelation has remained the most mysterious book in the Bible. Many intelligent scholars, faithful priests and preachers have attempted to decode its prophecies. Some have successfully interpreted the prophetic meaning of the seven letters to the seven churches, but none have been able to unlock the true meaning of the visions recorded on the scroll.

The primary reason no one could decode these visions is the divine authority required to unseal their mystery. As described in Revelation chapter 5, when the One seated on the throne held out the scroll written on both sides and sealed with seven seals, “*no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth could open the scroll or even look inside it.*” Only Christ the Lamb was worthy with the authority to break the seals and open the scroll. (Revelation 5:1-10)

Even after the seals were broken and the scroll was opened, no one understood the visions for the past two thousand years. This is because God’s prophecies are not meant to be fully decoded before they are fulfilled. That’s another reason that the visions in the Book of Revelation could not be decoded in the past two thousand years.

Now, as the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible has come with the Authority of the Messiah, and as most of the prophecies in the Book of Revelation have already been fulfilled, the time has come to unveil the two-thousand-year mystery of the Book of Revelation. Contrary to what many have believed, the visions on the scroll are not about disasters at the “End Time,” but rather about major historical events in Christian history over the past two millennia, from the early centuries all the way to the New Millennium.

To comprehend the true meaning of the prophecies in the Book of Revelation, people must examine how the prophecies in the Book of Daniel were fulfilled, for God is consistent in the way He fulfills His prophecies.

1. Multiple Visions for the Multiple Confirmation of God's Prophecies

In the Book of Daniel, there are three prophetic dream and visions: the dream of large statue (Daniel 2), the vision of four beasts (Daniel 7), and the vision of a ram and a goat (Daniel 8). All three prophesied the same historical events– the rising of four kingdoms: Babylon, Medo-Persia, Macedon-Greece, and Rome, spanning from the 600s BC to the 400s AD. God used three sets of dream and visions in the Book of Daniel to confirm the prophecy of the rising of these four kingdoms.

Similarly, the Book of Revelation contains two distinct sets of visions: the seven letters to the seven churches (Revelation 2-3) and the visions on the scroll (Revelation 6-22). Following the same divine pattern, these two sets of visions also prophesied the major historical events in the same historical period.

Although the seven letters to the seven churches appear to be ordinary pastoral messages containing Christ's words of warning, rebuke, encouragement, and promised rewards, they also carry profound prophetic meaning regarding the future development of Christianity over the next two thousand years.

Now, I will begin with the interpretation of the prophetic meaning of the first set of visions in the Book of Revelation: the seven letters to the seven churches.

2. The Prophetic Meaning of the Seven Letters to the Seven Churches

These seven churches were located in seven cities in Asia Minor– Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea-which are in present-day western Turkey.



The map of the seven cities where these seven churches were located

As the Book of Revelation is the final book of prophecy (Revelation 22:18-19) in the Bible, these seven letters to the seven churches also carry the prophetic meaning far beyond the literal teachings of Christ to these seven churches in Asia Minor. They prophesy the seven phases or periods of Christianity over the next two thousand years.

Here is a summary of the prophetic meaning of the seven letters to the seven churches:

1) The Letter to the Church in Ephesus

The name of the first city, “Ephesus”, means “desirable, appealing” in Greek. This indicates the roles of the Apostles as the “*golden lampstands*” for Christians in the early church. In this letter, Christ praised the early Christians for their deeds, hard work and perseverance, but reprimanded them for forsaking their first love.

This Letter to the Church in Ephesus represents the **Apostolic Period of Christianity (30 – 100 AD)**, when the Apostles preached the Gospel across the Roman Empire from Jerusalem to Rome, including Asia Minor. However, the Apostle Peter acted too harshly when he rebuked the couple Ananias and Sapphira to death after they withheld some of their possessions. (Acts 5:1-10)

2) The Letter to the Church in Smyrna

The name “Smyrna” is derived from the word “myrrh”, a bitter gum and aromatic perfume used as an antiseptic for embalming. The name “Smyrna” therefore carries the meaning of “suffering and preserving”. In this letter, Christ warned the Christians that they would suffer persecution, with “*afflictions and poverty,*” and that some would be tested “*even to the point of death.*” (Revelation 2:9-10)

This Letter to the Church in Smyrna prophesies the **Persecution Period of Christianity (100 – 313 AD)**, during which early Christians suffered heavy persecution from the Roman Empire.

3) The Letter to the Church in Pergamum

The name “Pergamum” in Greek means “strongly united,” “knitted together”, or “elevated.” This was the period when the state and the church became closely united and Christianity was elevated to the status of the state religion of the Roman Empire. In this letter, Christ pointed out that they were living “*where Satan has his throne,*” yet they remained true to His name. (Revelation 2:13) Christ also warned that many would fall into false teaching, and that He would come soon to “*fight against them with the sword of my mouth.*” (Revelation 2:14-16)

This Letter to the Church in Pergamum prophesies the **Elevated Period of Christianity (313 – 590 AD)**, when Emperor Constantine the Great liberated Christians from government persecution, issued official decrees favoring Christianity, and laid the foundation for it to become the state religion of the Roman Empire in the late 300s AD.

4) The Letter to the Church in Thyatira

The word “Thyatira” means “burning of incense,” “sacrifice of perfume,” or “odor of affliction.” This points to the formalized rituals of the church, which included the burning of incense and other offerings. This letter issues a strong warning against the sins of Jezebel—sexual immorality and idolatry (Revelation 2:20)—but also give the church “*authority over the nations – ‘He will rule them with an iron scepter, he will dash them into pieces like pottery’ – just as I have received authority from my Father.*” (Revelation 2:26-27).

This Letter to the Church in Thyatira prophesies the **Authoritative Period of Christianity (590 – 1517 AD)**, when God granted the Roman Catholic Church a thousand years of Papal Authority over the Christian nations, beginning with Pope St. Gregory the Great (the “Father of the Medieval Papacy”), until the Church fell into the sins of Jezebel toward the end of the Medieval Age.

5) The Letter to the Church in Sardis

The word “Sardis” relates to “Sard” or “Sardonyx”, a precious red-and-white stone. The word “Sardius” is also the first of the twelve precious stones in the breastplate of the Jewish high priest (Exodus 28:17, KJV). This represents the most precious thing in Christianity: faith in Christ. In this letter, Christ gives a stern warning: *“I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God.”* (Revelation 3:1-2) This indicates the inadequacy of works without the salvation by faith through the Grace of God.

This Letter to the Church in Sardis prophesied the **Reformation Period of Christianity (1517 – 1730s AD)**, when Martin Luther launched the Protestant Reformation in 1517 by posting the 95 Theses on the door of All Saint’s Church in Wittenberg and emphasized on the Salvation by Faith Alone.

6) The Letter to the Church in Philadelphia

The word “Philadelphia” means “brotherly love”. In this letter, Christ indicates that He will open a door to the new world that no one can shut, and that a new nation of God would be born, led by a faithful leader like King David, characterized by “brotherly love” for all. Christ also promises to keep this nation *“from the hour of trial that is going to come on the whole world to test the inhabitants of the earth.”* (Revelation 3:10) Once victorious, the “New Jerusalem” will come down out of heaven to this new world, and Christ will come with His “new name” (Revelation 3:12).

This Letter to the Church in Philadelphia prophesies the **New World Period or Great Awakening Period of Christianity (1730s – 1900 AD)**. It corresponds to the birth of the new nation of God in the new world—the United States of America—led by a faithful leader like King David, George Washington. The nation was born in Philadelphia in 1776, following the Great Awakening that revived people’s faith in the British American colonies during the 1730s–1750s. Christ also kept His promise to protect the United States from the catastrophic destruction of World Wars I and II, allowing it to emerge as a superpower after the wars. He further prophesied that the “New Jerusalem” would come down from heaven to this new nation of God rather than to the old Jerusalem in Israel, and that He would have a “new name” at His Second Coming.

7) The Letter to the Church in Laodicea

The name “Laodicea” means “the opinions and judgment of the people or of the laymen.” In this letter, Christ rebukes those who pursue worldly wealth while losing their faith in God: *“You say, ‘I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.’ But you do not realize that you are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked.”* (Revelation 3:17) This points to the rise of secularism as the mainstream voice in the Christian world, with people increasingly pursuing secular desires. Christ then says, ***“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.”*** (Revelation 3:20)

This Letter to the Church in Laodicea prophesies the **Apostate Period of Christianity (1900s – 2000 AD)**, when people lost their faith in God after great technological achievements in the material world and replaced the Word of God with layman’s opinions. However, they are still *“wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked”* in the eyes of Christ. Therefore, after humanity falls into this apostate stage of history, Christ will come as a humble man, standing at the door and knocking. To anyone who hears His voice and opens the door, He will come in and dine with them, bringing them the Eternal Gospel with the great blessing of God.

3. The Visions on the Scroll in the Book of Revelation

Many people have been taught that the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation are about the disasters at the “End Time” or the Apocalypse at the “End of the World”. However, they missed the key characteristics of God’s prophecies in the Book of Daniel.

In the Book of Daniel, God used three sets of dream and visions to prophesy the same sequence of historical events: the rise of four kingdoms — Babylon, Medo-Persia, Macedon-Greece, and the Roman Empire — which expanded over more than a thousand years from the 600s BC to the 400s AD. How could all these visions in the Book of Revelation, which are far more numerous and complex than those in the Book of Daniel, possibly be fulfilled in such a short period of the “Seven-year Tribulation” during the “End Time”?

Ever since the New Millennium began in year 2000, many faithful people of God have recognized the signs of the “Second Coming” all over the world. They just wondered when the “Four Horsemen of Apocalypse” would appear to begin the visions of Apocalypse at the “End Time” before the “Second Coming”.

However, they have all misunderstood the visions of the “Four Riders on Four Colored Horses” at the beginning of the visions on the scroll in Chapter 6 of the Book of Revelation. These “Four Riders on Four Colored Horses” are not the “Four Horsemen of Apocalypse”, who would bring disasters to the world at the “End Time”, as most people have been taught for the past two thousand years. Instead, they actually prophesied the four major historical events and periods in early Christian history, just as the four beasts in the Book of Daniel prophesied the rise of the four ancient kingdoms.

Now, for the first time in history, the “Second Child” prophesied in the Bible (Revelation 12:5) reveals the true meaning of these “Four Riders on Four Colored Horses” in Chapter 6 of the Book of Revelation.

1) The Prophetic Meaning of the Four Riders on Four Colored Horses

i) The First Seal Opened: A Rider on a White Horse

After the Lamb opened the first of the seven seals, ***“there was a white horse. Its rider held a bow, and he was given a crown, and he rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest.”*** (Revelation 6:2)

The Historical Fulfillment:

The Roman Emperor Constantine the Great liberated Christians from persecution in 313 AD and established the first Christian Kingdom on earth by converting the Roman Empire to Christianity. Ever since then, the Christian kingdom has expanded across the world ***“as a conqueror bent on conquest.”***

Constantine the Great was chosen by Christ as the liberator of Christians in the Roman Empire, just as the Persian King Cyrus the Great was chosen by God as the “anointed” liberator of the Jews who had been taken captive by the Babylonians (Isaiah 44:28, 45:1, 13). Because of his significant contributions to the establishment of the first Christian kingdom on earth and his pivotal role in liberating Christians from persecution, God granted Constantine the Great the honor of appearing as a “Rider on a White Horse”, in the same way the Messiah of the “Second Coming” appears in the Book of Revelation 19:11.

ii) The Second Seal Opened: A Rider on a Red Horse

After the Lamb opened the second seal, ***“Then another horse came out, a fiery red one. Its rider was given power to take peace from the earth and to make people kill each other. To him was given a large sword.”*** (Revelation 6:4)

Historical Fulfillment:

Prophet Muhammad founded Islam in the Middle East in 610 AD and spread it throughout the Arab World by “**preaching the faith by the sword**”. Over the next century, Muslim armies expanded across the Arabian Peninsula and beyond, largely through military conquest.

This early emphasis on military conquest and fighting also influenced the succession of power within the Muslim community. Following Muhammad’s death, all four of his immediate successors (the Rashidun Caliphs) were assassinated amid power struggles, rebellions, and factional disputes. That's why, in this vision, the rider on a fiery red horse was given a large sword to “**take peace from the earth and to make people kill each other.**” (Revelation 6:4)

iii) The Third Seal Opened: A Rider on a Black Horse

After the Lamb opened the third seal, there was “**a black horse! Its rider was holding a pair of scales in his hand. Then I heard what sounded like a voice among the four living creatures, saying, ‘Two pounds of wheat for a day’s wages, and six pounds of barley for a day’s wages, and do not damage the oil and the wine!’**” (Revelation 6:5-6)

Historical Fulfillment:

The Islamic Empire expanded through a vast trading network during the Abbasid Dynasty — known as the “**Black Rider Dynasty.**” The voice announcing the prices of wheat and barley while cautioning against damage to oil and wine symbolizes marketplace trading activities. This prophesied the vibrant commercial prosperity of the Islamic world, enabled by extensive trade networks spanning Asia, Europe, and Africa.

This era is known as the Islamic Golden Age, a period of remarkable economic, scientific, and cultural achievements in Islamic history. However, the expansion of the Islamic Empire eventually led to conflicts with Christian nations in the Middle East and Asia Minor.

iv) The Fourth Seal Opened: A Rider on a Pale Horse

After the Lamb opened the fourth seal, there was “**a pale horse! Its rider was named Death, and Hades was following close behind him. They were given power over a fourth of the earth to kill by sword, famine and plague, and by the wild beasts of the earth.**” (Revelation 6:8)

Historical Fulfillment:

The Dark Age from the 1100s to the 1400s AD that filled with disasters—wars, famine, plague, and barbaric Mongol invasion and destruction—which killed “**a fourth of the population on earth.**”

This was the Dark Age for both the Christian world in Europe and the Islamic world in the Middle East. It was marked by major disasters—wars, famines, plagues, and barbaric invasions that destroyed civilizations.

The Major Wars in the Dark Age

- The Wars of Crusades, (1096–1291 AD)
- The Hundred Years’ War (1336–1453 AD)
- The Fall of Byzantine/Constantinople (1453 AD)

The Big Famine (1315–1317 AD)

The Plague of Black Death (1346–1351 AD)

The Wild Beast – The Barbaric Invasion of Mongols (1223–1242 AD)

The visions of the “Four Riders on Four Colored Horses” prophesied the four historical periods and events spanning roughly a thousand years from 313 AD to the 1400s AD. This is the same way the visions of the four beasts in the Book of Daniel were fulfilled. It confirms that God is consistent in His method of prophecy and fulfillment through historical events in the history of Israel, Christianity, and Islam.

2) The Major Historical Events Prophesied in the Rest of the Book of Revelation

In the rest of Chapter 6 of the Book of Revelation, after the fifth seal was opened, there were slain souls under the altar crying out to God for justice (Revelation 6:9-11). This prophesied the religious persecution within the church, especially the Inquisition of the 15th-16th century.

After the sixth seal was opened, signs of God’s judgment appeared as the sun turned black, the moon turned red, the stars fell from the sky, and people on the earth were terrified (Revelation 6:12-17). However, God had mercy on the people of the earth and called off the judgment just before it was about to be carried out by the four angels at the beginning of Chapter 7 of the Book of Revelation. This led to the Protestant Reformation prophesied in Chapter 7 of the Book of Revelation.

In the following chapters of the Book of Revelation, the visions on the scroll prophesy major historical events in the next five hundred years:

- The Religious Wars between Protestants and Catholics in Europe (16th to early 18th century)
- The New Exodus to the New World — the birth of the United States of America (17th-18th century)
- The French Revolution and the Napoleonic Wars (1789 – 1815)
- The Second Great Awakening and the rise of Mormonism in the United States (19th century)
- The American Civil War (1861-1865) and World Wars I & II in the early 20th century
- The Communist Revolution in the 20th century, the birth of the “Second Child” in the Bible, and the end of the “Cold War” in the 1990s
- The Spiritual Awakening of the Messiah of the “Second Coming” at the beginning of the New Millennium in year 2000
- The New Revelation of the “Eternal Gospel” for “every nation, tribe, language and people,” and the “September 11” terrorist attacks as the warning of the “Fall of Babylon”
- The plague of AIDS, water pollution, the war in Iraq, and the potential “Armageddon” in the Middle East
- The “Fall of Babylon”
- The Grand Finale of the “Second Coming” for the New Millennium of Peace & Wisdom

All these major historical events in the past seventeen hundred years were prophesied by the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation. Since the Book of Revelation contains far more visions than the Book of Daniel, it is entirely reasonable that the visions in the Book of Revelation cover a much longer period of time than the thousand-year period covered by the visions and dream in the Book of Daniel.

Therefore, all the past speculations that interpret the visions in the Book of Revelation as the Apocalypse or catastrophes at the “End Time” are incorrect. III. The Spiritual Significance of the Divine Revelation in the Book of Revelation

Although there have been several well-known books of prophecy in the world — such as the Book of Daniel, the Book of Isaiah, and the Book of Ezekiel in the Bible, as well as Nostradamus’ *The Centuries* — the Book of Revelation has three unique spiritual significance that no other books of prophecies can match.

1. The Book of Revelation Covers the Longest Historical Period in the World

The Books of Isaiah and Ezekiel contain various prophecies scattered throughout their texts. Nostradamus' The Centuries only prophesied historical events of the last five hundred years, and these were spread randomly without following chronological order. The Book of Daniel came close to the Book of Revelation, as it prophesied the rise of four kingdoms that spanned over a thousand-year period. However, it only covered four major historical events.

In contrast, the Book of Revelation not only prophesies all the major historical events in Christian and Middle Eastern history over the past two thousand years, but also presents them in chronological order as they actually occurred. It provides powerful historical testimony to the New Testament and proves that God's prophecies are real.

In the Old Testament, there are historical books such as 1 and 2 Chronicles and 1 and 2 Kings, so that the people of Israel could learn lessons from history and reaffirm their faith even after two thousand years of exile from their homeland. The New Testament, however, was compiled in the fourth century and did not have sufficient time to include such historical testimony.

Now, with the decoding of the visions in the Book of Revelation, people can see that God has always been watching over human history from above and has sent His angels to intervene whenever humanity strayed from the right path. This is the historical testimony that was missing from the New Testament. Therefore, the historical fulfillment of the visions in the Book of Revelation serves as the equivalent of the Books of Chronicles for the New Testament.

2. The Book of Revelation is the Only Book of Prophecy Revealing the Interventions from Heaven

Unlike other books of prophecy, which only show visions of events on the earthly level, the Book of Revelation is the only prophetic book that reveals visions from the heavenly perspective in the spiritual realm. This is because John was lifted to heaven to see "*what must take place after this.*" (Revelation 4:1) This heavenly viewpoint allows the Book of Revelation to show how God and His angels have intervened from heaven behind all the major historical events on earth over the past two thousand years.

In the last century, many people lost their faith in God because of government-endorsed secularism and atheist ideology taught in public schools and promoted in government institutions. Darwin's Theory of Evolution further convinced millions that everything on earth happened purely by random chance, with no Creator or divine intervention behind the scenes. The Communist Revolution in the twentieth century also turned approximately one-third of the nations on earth against God. Together, these forces led vast numbers of people away from faith in God.

Now that the historical fulfillment of the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation has been revealed, people can finally see how God has been actively intervening from heaven throughout human history. While God grants people free will to make their own choices, He retains the ultimate authority to make the final judgment in the end. All these major historical events were pre-planned and prophesied two thousand years ago, just for people to learn the lesson from history and reaffirm their faith in God.

Therefore, it is essential for all Christians and people of God to study the historical fulfillment of the visions in the Book of Revelation. It is the key to reviving and strengthening people's faith in God and in Christ. This forms the first part of the New Revelation of the Eternal Gospel for the New Millennium of Peace & Wisdom, as prophesied in the Book of Revelation 14:6.

3. The Spiritual Rapture for the “Second Coming”

Many people believe that when the time of the “Second Coming” arrives, there will be a “Rapture” for people of faith to be lifted up into the air to avoid the dreadful judgment of God on the earth at the “End of the World”. Some people expect to be lifted *“in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air”* (1 Thessalonians 4:17). This is the same spiritual metaphor as described in the preceding verse in the same epistle: *“For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.”* (1 Thessalonians 4:16).

As stated earlier, the supernatural phenomenon of Christ descending from heaven with thousands of angels following Him is a spiritual events occurs in the spiritual realm. In the same way, the “rapture” described in this scripture is also a spiritual phenomenon in the spiritual realm. In the Book of Revelation — the final version of all biblical prophecies — there is no vision of a large amount of people being physically lifted into the air. However, there are two clear examples of spiritual rapture in the Book of Revelation.

The first case of spiritual rapture is that John was spiritually lifted from the Island of Patmos into heaven to see the visions of future events from the spiritual realm. *“After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, ‘Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.’ **At once I was in the Spirit,** and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it.”* (Revelation 4:1-2) This is a spiritual lift, not a physical lift.

The second case of spiritual rapture is that “Male Child” born under the reign of the “Red Dragon” in Revelation 12. *“The dragon stood in front of the woman who was about to give birth, so that it might devour her child the moment he was born. She gave birth to a son, a male child, who ‘will rule all the nations with an iron scepter.’ **And her child was snatched up to God and to his throne.**”* (Revelation 12:4-5)

As that “Male Child” in Revelation 12:5, I have been spiritually lifted to the throne of God after my birth to protect me from being detected and devoured by the Red Dragon, but my physical body have remained on the earth to grow up like an ordinary boy. After I was spiritually awakened in the year 2000, I can see the historical events in the world from a heavenly perspective. That’s how I can decode the visions on the scroll through the interaction between heaven and earth. Because most people could only see the historical events from the earthly level, no one has been able to decode the visions on the scroll in the Book of Revelation for the past two thousand years. Only the One who has been lifted to the heavenly level can decode these visions on the scroll from a heavenly perspective.

Now, I have come to reveal the true meaning of the vision on the scroll as well as the “Eternal Gospel” for “every nation, tribe, language and people”, as proclaimed in Revelation 14:6. I will help people to see the worldly events from a heavenly perspective and eliminate the religious conflicts on the earthly level. Those who learn the New Revelation of the “Eternal Gospel” for the New Millennium will be lifted into a higher spiritual dimension with higher spiritual consciousness. This is the spiritual rapture for the “Second Coming” that people have been waiting for.

IV. The Divine Revelation on the Peaceful Solution to End the Wars in the World

In the past five years, there have been several major conflicts and wars around the world that could potentially lead to World War III or even the catastrophic nuclear war of “Armageddon” as prophesied in the Book of Revelation. God has mercy on those people who are suffering in these wars. Here are brief summaries of the Divine Revelations on the Peaceful Solution to end these wars and conflicts in the world.

1. The Divine Revelation on the Peaceful Solution to End the War in Iran



Ever since the extremist Islamic regime took power in Iran through the Islamic Revolution in 1979, it has been waging war against the United States of America, either directly or through its proxies. This began with the storming of the U.S. Embassy in Tehran on November 4, 1979, and holding of 66 Americans hostage for 444 days until January 20, 1981. On October 23, 1983, Iran-backed Hezbollah terrorists killed 241 U.S. military personnel and 58 French in a truck bombing at a Marine compound in Beirut, Lebanon. During the Iraq war between 2003 and 2011, Iran-backed militias killed over 600 U.S. troops in Iraq. Between October 2003 and November 2024, Iran and its proxies conducted more than 180 attacks against U.S. forces in the Middle East, wounding more than 180 U.S. service members and killing three.

On October 7, 2023, Hamas launched a terrorist attack on Israel from the Gaza Strip, killing about 1,200 Israelis and foreign visitors and abducting 251 individuals. In retaliation, Israel Defense Forces bombed and invaded the Gaza Strip, killed almost all high-ranking Hamas commanders in Gaza, and caused over 70,000 deaths and over 170,000 injuries. Once a war begins, the casualties will skyrocket.

Iran is the main sponsor of these terrorist groups, which serve as its proxies in the Middle East. If Iran acquires nuclear weapons and passes them to its proxies, such as Hamas or Hezbollah, these jihadist terrorist groups will not hesitate to use them against Israel and the U.S. forces in the Middle East. This would trigger a catastrophic nuclear war in the Middle East, in which millions of people—both Muslims and Israelis—would lose their lives. Such a catastrophe would dwarf the casualties in the current fighting in Gaza and would turn into the Catastrophe of “Armageddon” prophesied in the Bible (Revelation 16:15).

In January 2026, the extremist Iranian regime brutally massacred over 40,000 unarmed Iranian protesters across the nation. This is an unforgivable atrocity against humanity. That is why God sent superior military forces from the United States and Israel to punish this terrorist regime for their horrible crimes against its own people. Almost all those responsible for the massacre of 40,000 unarmed Iranians in January 2026 were eliminated, and they will also face the eternal judgment of God in the afterlife.

For the past five decades, the Iranian people have suffered persecution and oppression under the medieval-style authoritarian theocracy of the extremist Islamic regime. This theocracy in Iran is repeating the same mistakes as the theocracies in Europe during the Dark Age five hundred years ago. God has mercy on the 90 million Iranians who have been deprived of their freedom of speech and freedom of religion while enduring skyrocketing inflation and severe economic hardship. It is time to end the Dark Age of Theocracy in Iran, just as Europe did five hundred years ago, and to stop the extremist Islamic regime from massacring its own people and attacking neighboring Gulf nations, thereby bringing lasting peace to the Middle East.

The most effective means of achieving this objective is to establish a new democratic and secular government, jointly led by exiled Prince Reza Pahlavi and current Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian. Such a partnership would foster national reconciliation while excluding interference from the theocratic Mullah class. Given that most of Iran's current leaders have never lived in a modern democratic society before and have little experience with how democracy works, Prince Reza Pahlavi stands as the most suitable figure to guide the Iranian people through a peaceful transition from a medieval-style, closed society to a modern democratic nation that upholds freedom of speech and freedom of religion for all Iranian people.

Once the new democratic government is established, the international sanctions will be lifted and Iran's abundant natural resources will help the country recover quickly from its current financial crisis. God has mercy on the long-oppressed Iranian people. It is God's plan to use the United States to end the Dark Age in Iran under the current extremist authoritarian regime, just as God used the United States and its allies to end Saddam Hussein's authoritarian regime of in Iraq twenty years ago.

Today, Iraq has become a much more peaceful and developing country in the Middle East. It is time for Iranians to learn from Iraq's experience and work with the United States — instead of fighting against it — to establish a new democratic government of the Iranian people, by the Iranian people, and for the Iranian people. It will transform Iran from a medieval-style theocratic country into a modern democratic nation with peace and prosperity, just as Iraq has done over the past ten years.

2. The Divine Revelation on the Peaceful Solution to End the War in Ukraine



The war in Ukraine has now lasted more than four years since Russia's invasion in February 2022. Both nations have lost hundreds of thousands of lives in this tragic conflicts. It is time to end this senseless war between two brother nations bound by over a thousand years of shared history and common ancestry.

In the 8th century, Scandinavian migrants known as Varangians or Vikings expanded into Eastern Europe and established the medieval federation of Kievan Rus'. Its original capital was founded in Novgorod before being moved to Kiev in 882 AD. Kievan Rus' became the common ancestor of the modern nations of Russia, Belarus, and Ukraine.

In the 10th century, Vladimir the Great rose to power and forged an alliance with the Byzantine Empire. He led the conversion of Kievan Rus' to Christianity and introduced Byzantine culture to the realm. The resulting synthesis of Byzantine and Slavic traditions ushered in a cultural and economic Golden Age, laying the common religious and cultural foundation shared by both Russians and Ukrainians today.

Over the following millennium, the territory of Ukraine changed hands repeatedly: from Kievan Rus' (882–1240) to the Golden Horde (1240–1480), the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth (15th–17th centuries), the Russian Empire (1686–1917), and the Soviet Union (1922–1991). Ukraine finally gained independence in 1991 following the dissolution of the Soviet Union.

After its independence from the Soviet Union in 1991, Ukraine still maintained good relations with Russia until the Euromaidan Revolution in February 2014, which led to the ousting of the pro-Russian President Victor Yanukovich. On March 1, 2014, Russian President Putin deployed the Russian troops to take complete control of Crimea. A referendum was held on March 16, 2014, in which the majority of voters—predominantly ethnic Russians—supported joining Russia. Russia formally annexed Crimea on March 18, 2014. However, neither Ukraine nor the United Nations recognizes the legitimacy of this annexation.

In May 2014, a majority of Russian-speaking residents in the Donetsk and Luhansk regions also held a referendum seeking independence from the new pro-Western government in Ukraine. Most ethnic Russians in these areas expressed a preference for reunification with Russia. At the time, however, Putin did not recognize the independence of Donetsk and Luhansk as he had done with Crimea, in the hope of preserving some influence over Ukraine. The resulting separatist movement led to armed conflict between pro-Russian separatist militias and Ukrainian government forces, joined by various pro-Ukrainian militias.

From 2014 to 2022, intense fighting continued in the Donbas region between Ukrainian government troops and pro-Russian separatist forces, the latter supported by Russian military assistance. The conflict resulted in the deaths of over three thousand ethnic Russian civilians in eastern Ukraine. Reports of extreme violence by certain Ukrainian militias—including the torture and killing of pro-Russian civilians, among them women and children—further inflamed Russian nationalist sentiment and calls for retaliation within Russia.

During the same period, the Ukrainian government enacted legislation restricting the use of the Russian language in public life, which generated deep resentment among the approximately 40 percent of Ukraine's population that speaks Russian as its primary language, particularly in Eastern Ukraine. The rise of Ukrainian nationalism, combined with Ukraine's expressed intention to join NATO, ultimately contributed to Putin's decision to launch a full-scale invasion of Ukraine in February 2022.

With substantial military and financial support from the United States and the European Union, Ukraine successfully withstood Russia's initial large-scale offensive, but also suffered great loss in both casualties and territories. Russia has gained control of significant territory in southeastern Ukraine, including the four oblasts of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia, and Kherson, despite its failed offense in the northern front.

In recent years, the Donbas region—particularly Donetsk and Luhansk—has become the primary battlefield. Hundreds of thousands of young Ukrainians and Russians have lost their lives in this devastating conflict. The territorial dispute over these four oblasts in southeastern Ukraine has also become the main obstacle to reaching a peace agreement between the two nations.

As God is merciful, He has compassion on both the war-weary Ukrainians and ethnic Russians in eastern Ukraine. It is time to end this war and cease the fratricidal bloodshed between these two brother nations.

Here is the divine judgment of God with a fair settlement for both sides:

1. Russia and Ukraine shall split the four oblasts in Southeastern Ukraine.

Since ethnic Russians form the majority in Donetsk and Luhansk, Russia could retain control of these two regions in accordance with the 2014 referendums, while returning the occupied parts of Zaporizhzhia and Kherson to Ukraine, where Ukrainians constitute the majority.

2. Russia may retain sovereignty over Crimea but should establish a joint administrative arrangement with Ukraine to safeguard the legal rights of Ukrainians same as the Russian residents in Crimea.

Since Crimea was annexed by the Russian Empire in 1783 and later transferred to Ukraine by Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev in 1954 as a symbolic gift during the peak of Russian-Ukrainian brotherhood, most of its residents are ethnic Russians or pro-Russian Ukrainians. That is why, in the March 2014 referendum, over 90% of voters favored returning to Russia. It is appropriate to respect the will of the people expressed in the 2014 referendum while ensuring full protection of the rights of all residents, including Ukrainians, in the peninsula.

3. Russia should provide compensation for war damage to Ukraine through revenue derived from its oil and gas exports.

Since Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, the war has caused extensive destruction to Ukrainian cities and infrastructure. Millions of Ukrainians have lost their homes, with many forced to seek refuge in neighboring countries. It is Russia's responsibility to provide compensation for the damage it has inflicted. Russia should compensate Ukraine for the war damage and contribute to its post-war reconstruction using its energy revenues once international sanctions on Russian oil and gas are lifted.

4. Ukraine may join the EU for Economic Development but not NATO for military alliance.

The main cause of the Euromaidan Revolution (late 2013 to early 2014) was that the pro-Russian President Yanukovich abruptly abandoned a planned political and free trade agreement with the European Union (EU) in favor of closer economic ties with Russia. Most Ukrainians, who preferred EU integration, began protesting in November 2013 and eventually ousted pro-Russian President Yanukovich in February 2014. This prompted Russia to forcibly annex Crimea in March 2014. Ukraine officially announced its intention to join NATO in 2017 while cracking down on pro-Russian separatists in the eastern Donbas region. These actions eventually contributed to Russia's full-scale invasion in 2022.

While the will of the majority of Ukrainians to join the European Union should be respected, Russia's security concern regarding Ukraine joining NATO should also be considered. The best solution to balance the concerns on both sides is to allow Ukraine to join the EU for economic development while it withholds its plan to join NATO for military alliance.

5. Ukraine should reduce hostility and repeal discriminatory laws against ethnic Russians in Ukraine

Since the Euromaidan Revolution in 2014, and particularly following the annexation of Crimea, hostility toward Russia has intensified in Ukraine. Ukraine also enacted a new language law that restricted the use of Russian. These hostile and discriminatory measures caused deep resentment among the large Russian-

speaking population, both inside Ukraine and in Russia, ultimately contributing to the outbreak of the war. It is now time to reduce hostility and repeal discriminatory laws against ethnic Russians in Ukraine.

As both nations are Christian—predominantly Orthodox, with significant Catholic communities—**they should return to the teachings of Jesus Christ on love and forgiveness**. Only through these principles can the two brother nations achieve lasting peace and “**beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks.**” (Isaiah 2:4)
